General Information

Student will:

1. Possess an overall scholastic average of 3.0 in a 4.0 scale. Average **MUST** be **UN-WEIGHTED**.
2. Submit an official current state officer application **2 weeks prior** to the district leadership meeting to the District Adviser, forwarding a copy to Mr. Janet Johnson, State Adviser and to Darlene K. Evans, Election Coordinator. An official transcript should accompany the application.
3. Submit a copy of all required paperwork for election directly to **Darlene K. Evans**, State Elections Coordinator, either electronically or hard copy. Email address is devans@chatham.k12.nc.us and postal mailing address is Northwood High School, 310 NHS Road, Pittsboro, North Carolina 27312 and to **Janet L. Johnson, NC FCCLA State Adviser, 6360 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-6360. E-Mail address is jljohnson@dpi.state.nc.us .**
4. Be a member in good standing for one year or in the process of completing one year of active membership demonstrating leadership experience on the resume.
5. Have completed or be in the process of completing all 5 units of the Power of One national program. One copy of Summary sheet should be forwarded to Darlene K. Evans prior to February 1st of the election year and another copy to the State coordinator of Powers of One.
6. Present a 2 minute speech on a topic designed by the State Adviser and the State Election Coordinator and their steering committee.
7. Answer 2 questions composed and sent from the state department. One **FACT** question and one **Situation** question.
8. Dress in appropriate **Business Attire**. No Blue Jeans – if worn, automatic disqualification.
9. **Not** carry a hand held item or prop.
10. **Not** dressed in costume.
11. **Not** campaign.

Once all students have given their presentation, voting will take place and the winner will be announced at the district meeting.

Please Note:

1. A student can be a student officer more than once but not in consecutive years.
2. A state officer can run for a national office as per the national guidelines. If that candidate is not elected he/she **may be considered** for a position as a consultant to the Executive Council.
3. A state officer is **not allowed** to compete in **Star Events** during his/her term of office.
4. The local adviser to the state officer is **expected** to travel with and take responsibility for his/her officer in performing their duties within this exiting organization.
5. **State officers and their local advisers are required to attend Leadership Training in June before attending the National FCCLA Leadership Conference in July. State officers must attend the National Conference.**
6. The state officer application has been revised and can be found on the www.ncfccla.com website.
